OUR WORK IN THE COMMUNITY

Prison Ministry—Visits the local detention centre meeting with youth providing guidance and direction using God’s Word as the foundation. The ministry, ABVHM, contributes bibles and other Christian booklets to the facility. In addition, ministers to families of the inmates providing guidance and support, in many cases material goods, and assistance regarding community support agencies.

Speaking Engagements—Visits churches in London and the surrounding communities bringing the Word of God and the work of the ministry to the congregations.

Other Activities—Active in visiting the local group homes providing clothing, books, encouragement, and support in areas of need. When called upon, visits and ministers to those in hospital.

Prayer & Counselling—Responds to calls from grieving families, single mothers, and others in need of support for prayer and counselling. Many praise reports of answered prayers and needs met have been received.

TRANSFORMING LIVES

In 2004, ABVHM took on a project in Accra, Ghana, West Africa to establish a facility that would provide rehabilitation services for the youth who are being released from prison. We have given our facility the name, **“FAITH HOME”**.

FAITH HOME allows the youth to begin the process of reintegration with society and the local community while still providing monitoring and support. There is an active rehabilitation program run throughout the day providing daily living skills, education, and employment skills, plus a program to find new housing and employment within the community.

FAITH HOME is a Christian faith based facility that adheres to and applies biblical standards and teachings. Residents are newly released prisoners who have received Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Part of the facility includes a Chapel with regular church services and support.

FAITH HOME creates an important bridge between institutional care and community living for the individual resident and for the future of Ghana.

FAITH HOME is the very first of its kind in Ghana, West Africa to meet the ever important and increasing need for the youth and the country.
